

## Burgenland: Mittelburgenland DAC



**Size & Location:** 2,150 ha/5,289 acres South of Neusiedlersee-Hugelland in central Burgenland.

**Important Villages:** Deutschkreutz, Horitschon, Lutzmannsburg and Neckenmarkt.

**Soil Types:** Loamy flatland with heavy rich soils that hold water for long periods of time.

**Varietals & Style:** Blaufränkisch is the most important varietal. Zweigelt, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot also thrive here.

**Climate:** Warm with conditions are favorable to red wine production. The vineyards are protected by a series of hills on all sides of the district.

### Important Facts

- Two large co-operatives, Vereinte Winzer Horitschon and Winzerkeller Neckenmarkt, produce most of the wine in Mittelburgenland.
- **Producers of Note:** Gesellmann, Hienrich, Iglar, Kerschbaum, Wellanschitz, and Weninger.
