

Lower Austria / Niederösterreich: Wagram



Size & Location: 2,800 ha/6,888 acres. Area to the West of Wien (Vienna). New area once a part of the former district of Donauland.

Important Villages: Feuersbrunn, Fels, Kirchberg and Grossriedenthal.

Soil Types: Deep layers of loess that are rich in fossils and minerals

Varietals & Style: Grüner Veltliner, Roter Veltliner, Zweigelt and Pinot Noir.

Climate: Pannonian climate; warm sunny days and cool nights.

- New area as of 2007. Formally known as Donauland or land of the Danube.
- Known for good Grüner Veltliner, Zweigelt and Pinot Noir.
- Powerful red wines are produced predominantly from the grape varieties Blauer Zweigelt and Pinot noir
- Sweet wines and Eisweins of particular quality are well known in Wagram
